Tier 1 Words (basic vocabulary)

stronger in ALL of you Words we use all of the time: dog, cat, house, gree These are words that you will already know!

Tier 2 Words (Academic Vocabulary)

Sophisticated words that fit into lots of subjects.

The better knowledge you have of these words the more success you will have in all subjects! Examples: fundamental, affect, context, evaluate - They help with your writing, reading and speaking. These are the words that make you stronger!




Tier 3 Subject Specific Terminology Words that you need to learn specifically for your subjects.
